TRAVEL BAG LARGE ENOUGH TO CARRY EVERYTHING LISTED BELOW EXCEPT BEDDING ROLL - NO SUITCASES

GUIDE SHOULD PACK THEIR OWN BAG AND BE ABLE TO CARRY EVERYTHING HERSELF

** PLEASE BRING 2 PIECES of FRUIT and PICNIC TEA for FRIDAY NIGHT **

NO MOBILE PHONES OR DEVICES

CAMP UNIFORM - to be worn to and from camp Blue Shorts/jeans/tracksuit pants Blue Polo Shirt (no badges/sash - they get lost!) Blue jumper/windcheater Closed-in shoes

EXTRA CLOTHING

- 1 spare jeans or track pants (only 1 needed)
- 1 T shirt or skivvy
- 1 jumper
- 1 spare shoes (eg sneakers no sandals)
- 2 pr socks
- 2 sets underwear
- 1 PJ's or tracksuit for sleeping
- Beanie or Camp Hat

Waterproof & Warm Coat with hat or hood (essential)

At least 6 Freezer Bags (medium/large)

Clothing for Caving:

OLD clothes with long legs and arms that can get dirty Shoes that have some tread (eg sneakers) Gloves and kneepads are useful

EQUIPMENT FOR BEDDING ROLL

Aerobic mat

Sleeping Bag

Small old blanket

Small pillow

Groundsheet (1.5 x 2.2 approx, no smaller, and not much bigger)

Camp Blanket

Gadget cord - 6 metres, 4mm cotton or nylon cord.

OTHER EQUIPMENT

Head Torch or working torch (essential) + spare batteries (not rechargeable)

Sunscreen & Insect repellant (roll on or cream - no aerosols)

Notebook and pencil

Small Hike backpack (to take on bus with Friday dinner & for caving)

TOILETRIES

Soap, washer, toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush/comb, deodorant Sanitary Items (if required)

1 Towel (in plastic bag)

Plastic bag for dirty clothes

MESS KIT (Dilly Bag) - all items to be unbreakable, named and brought in drawstring bag

- 1 Large plate, 1 Small plate, 1 Cereal bowl, 1 Mug, 1 Knife, fork and spoon
- 2 Tea towels

Oven glove

Sit-upon (plastic square)

Water bottle
