



OUTDOOR PROGRAM IDEAS

Knot Relay


- This is a fun way to practice knots learned in preparation for camp or just to practice!
- Teach the girls some knots first, or if they already know them have a quick refresher
- Then have patrols line up at one end of the hall (or outside)
- Check for obstacles / dangers
- Leader calls out a knot and the first Guide from each patrol runs up to her to tie it and show it
- Leader says if it is correct and then Guide runs back
- The first to get back gets a point for her patrol
- Repeat so everyone gets a turn
- You can also play this to practice square lashing the first girl puts on the clove hitch and shows that to the leader the second does the unders and overs the third does the frapping the fourth does the reef knot first team to finish wins leader can also check to make sure it's tight and neat if there are more girls who need a turn.




