WHERE:	Mittagong Camp @ Lara		
TRAVEL:	Meet Saturday morning at Mordialloc Station for travel via Southern		
	Cross to Lara & return to Mordialloc Station Sunday afternoon		
	Arrive at Mordialloc Station no later than 8.15am with all forms filled in		
	correctly.		
	All guides will have a "prepaid authority ticket" which will mean they		
TIME:	do not need their MYKI cards as the ticket from Mordialloc to Lara &		
	return will be prepaid & we will enter & exit via the gates (not the turn		
	styles).		
	Mordialloc to Southern Cross – approximately 8.44am train leaves		
	Southern Cross to Lara – approximately 9.50am train leaves (41 minutes		
	travel)		
	Lara to Southern Cross – approximately 1.19pm train leaves		
	Southern Cross to Mordialloc – approximately 2.16pm train leaves		
	Arrival at Mordialloc station approximately 3.06pm		
COST:	\$90 per guide (includes train travel, badge, accommodation, food &
